Outline of programme of work

Household Shopping

Students will learn about shopping and will plan and carry out shopping trips and become familiar with paying for household goods in supermarkets and shops in their local area.

D - For some learners handling money and identifying coins will be a key skill taught each week.

Key Objectives

1. Learners to develop independence skills and will work towards units of interest and to meet individual needs and develop social and communication skills.
2. Learners will take part in visits, demonstrations and skills assessments and record evidence in a portfolio to be externally moderated.
